Bursary Guidelines

Bursaries are awarded to students enrolled at Weengushk Film Institute for the Lab 1: Certificate in Film Production and Lab 2: Certificate in Television Production. These awards are supported through annual donors. To be given an award, a one page essay must be handed in. The essay must include how and why receiving a bursary will help the applicant in reaching their educational goals and how the program will contribute to creating a path for their future career.

Additionally, the bursary can be revoked under these circumstances if the applicant:

- Does not continue with full-time enrollment
- Has poor attendance during each module
- Grades do not meet the Weengushk Film Institute standard of 70% in each module.

In the event that the bursary is revoked, a student has the right to appeal the decision if there are extenuating circumstances that impact the students ability to continue their studies. An extenuating circumstance is an unexpected event that is beyond the students control and must have supporting documentation.

How much can I get?

The bursaries range from \$2,500 up to \$12,000 for tuition fees.

Who is eligible?

These bursaries are open to everyone who applies to our programs and are in financial need. Some requirements are

- Applicant is 18yrs and older
- Accepted and enrolled in one of our full-time programs
- Has provided Weengushk Film Institute with a one page essay
