



Quick Facts

- Femicide, most broadly defined, means the gender-based killing of women and girls and the most extreme form of violence towards them
- Since 1995 OAITH has tracked Ontario femicides from **November 26th to November 25th** on an annual basis.
- A total of **58 femicides** were included in the 2020-2021 Annual Femicide List



Cause of Death




Victim Age & Perpetrator Relationship Comparison


An ongoing limitation of OAITH's femicide data is the lack of race-related data included in media reports.

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Intimate partner femicide continues to be the most common type of femicide, accounting for 60% of all femicides occurring in Ontario in January 2022. As highlighted by the January femicide data, young women between the ages of 18-35 are most commonly killed in intimate partner femicides, either by their current or former partner. These findings highlight the need for increased education and prevention measures to be implemented for young girls and boys before they begin dating. Education on consent, healthy relationships, power, control and abuse, and healthy masculinity will be integral to preventing future gender-based violence.
