




Victim & Perpetrator Age Comparision




Cause of Death

Enhancing Connection to Services for Older Women Experiencing Violence

There were three confirmed femicides in January throughout Ontario and two cases that remain unconfirmed pending further police disclosure. Within the January data, we continue to see high-rates of femicide perpetrated against older women, as 66.7% of women killed this month were aged 55 and older. As seen within OAITH's femicide research, older women experience violence from a wide range of relationship types, including intimate partners, family members, other men known to them and may also experience targeted and gendered violence from men with whom they have no prior relationship. Older women may also face a number of barriers to services that are compounded with age, including the length of abuse, service wait times and lack of awareness of available supports (Aging Without Violence, 2020). A number of jury recommendations emerged from the recent Inquest into the Deaths of Helen Gladys Ryan and William Thomas Ryan to enhance training and policies related to intimate partner violence and violence against older women among health care providers and other health-related services. Specifically, these recommendations intend to assist communities in improving screening, identification of violence and risk and enhance collaboration with GBV services. Implementation of these jury recommendations would be a meaningful step to help to mitigate existing barriers to services and improve outcomes for older women experiencing violence.
