



- Femicides in Ontario continue to be most commonly perpetrated by the victim's current or former intimate partner.
- A total of **27 femicides** have been reported in Ontario since November 26, 2021.



Victim & Perpetrator Age Comparison




In the month of July, femicide victims and perpetrators were between the ages of 18-35 and 36-54.

Cause of Death




Victim Race



Unknown femicides can include cases where the victim was not known to the perpetrator but details suggest the killing was targeted and gendered as well as in cases where no information regarding their relationship has been provided.

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHT



Since the release of the 2020-2021 Annual Femicide List, OAITH has tracked at least 27 femicides in the province. Several unconfirmed femicide cases also continued to be monitored by OAITH pending further police investigation and disclosure. On average, there are three (3.37) femicides occurring every month in Ontario. The high rates of femicide in the province and throughout the country highlight the need for immediate action to improve outcomes for women, girls and gender-diverse individuals, including increased government collaboration, increased funding and a commitment to prevention. The implementation of the National Action Plan as outlined in the National Action Plan Roadmap is an essential step to preventing further femicides from occurring and ultimately eradicating gender-based violence throughout Canada.
