ANNUAL FEMICIDE LIST

NOVEMBER 26th 2024 to NOVEMBER 25th 2025

Femicide is broadly defined as gender-related killing of women and girls by men. OAITH tracks femicide through the use of media reports to bring attention and raise public awareness of gender-related killing in Ontario. Definitions of femicide can be complex and can encompass different relationships, criminal justice charges and motives, leading to evolving and at times, different definitions by those examining and analyzing when women and girls are killed.

OAITH defines femicide as the gender-related killing of women, children and gender-diverse individuals by men that occur in Ontario. Our team reviews and analyzes hundreds of media articles every year to examine relationships between victims and those charged or deemed responsible, prior history of violence, criminal justice charges laid at the time the crime was committed, cause of death, race, geography, age and the location where these crimes occur. This information is used to advocate for change with community members, journalists, government officials and public policy makers because we know that femicides are preventable.

Since 1990 we are aware of over 1,120 femicide victims who have lost their lives to men's violence. Every year we release our Annual Femicide List based on media reporting of women and children killed by men in Ontario. We work to ensure that we remember the lives lost, bring attention to the violence women experience, and take action to move our list to zero.

As we rely upon media reporting to determine when women and children have been killed in Ontario there can be missing information, errors or omissions. The Annual Femicide List captures the femicides and criminal justice charges that we are aware of at the time of publication. We acknowledge that this is a limitation and doesn't capture all killings or where women are found dead who don't receive any justice at all. We do continual media monitoring of these cases and acknowledge that systemic forms of racism and oppression contributes to the undervaluing of those most marginalized who are killed by men.

DECEMBER 14, 2024 - THUNDER BAY, ON

Deborah was from Sandy Lake First Nation and lived in Thunder Bay with her daughter and extended family. She had been working in the health care sector recently having graduated from Oshki-Pimache-O-Win: The Wenjack Education Institute and had dreams of pursuing further education. She was described as a role model, an inspiration to other students through her dedication, perseverance and kindness. Her family has said that, “We were her heart, just as she is ours. Deborah had a unique gift – one that left a mark on every soul she touched”. A 24 year old man has been charged with 2nd degree murder and indignity to a body in relation to Deborah’s death.

Jolene has been described as loving and always willing to help others in need, devoting a significant amount of her time to volunteering in her local community. Jolene was passionate about film and nature and had created documentaries detailing life in Nunavut before moving to Ottawa. Jolene will be forever remembered for her ability to bring light into every situation. She will be missed by her family, friends and many community members. A 35 year old man, reported to be related to Jolene, has been charged with 2nd degree murder in relation to Jolene’s death as well as attempted murder pertaining to a secondary victim.

Susan loved her family and was passionate about helping others. She pursued this passion through her career in the health care system, working as an operating room nurse at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre for 35 years. She loved her family and children deeply and loved vacationing in Algonquin Park where she found peace and joy. A 25 year old man, reported to be Susan’s adult son, has been charged with 1st degree murder in relation to his mother’s death. According to media reports, the accused was released on probation the day before Susan was killed.

Cause of Death: Unknown



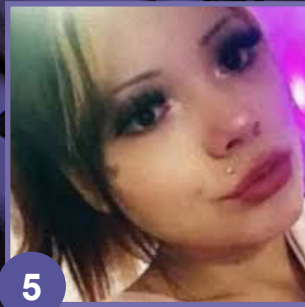


ALISHA BROOKS, 34

Alisha was a beloved community advocate, housing worker, and mother to a 16-year-old daughter. She is described by her family and friends as someone who was effervescent and vibrant, who lit up any room she was in. Alisha was passionate about helping others and advocated for children, youth, refugees and against gender-based violence. She was always willing to help anyone who needed it and was described as an inspiration to all around her. A 33 year old man, reported to be Alisha's intimate partner, has been charged with 1st degree murder in relation to her death. According to media reports, the accused had a criminal history of intimate partner violence and was on statutory release at the time Alisha was killed.

SERENITY BROWN, 21
SEPTEMBER 5, 2025 - TORONTO, ON

Serenity (Yaddie) Sincere Jetta-Mae Brown, Katsitsyu:tu of Oneida Nation, was a kind soul and a beloved member of her family. Serenity loved music and embraced her language and culture at her school TsiNiyukwaliho: on Oneida. She brought sunshine and laughter into everyone's lives and will be forever missed by those who say that "it was a privilege to have her in our lives even for this short time". A 48 year old man, reported to be known to Serenity, has been charged with 2nd degree murder in relation to her death.

SACHA CHARLES, 46
OCTOBER 31, 2025 - BARRIE, ON

Sacha will be forever remembered as a devoted mother and friend to many. She will be missed greatly. A 46 year old man, reported to be Sacha's intimate partner, has been charged with 2nd degree murder in relation to her death. According to media reports, neighbours were at times fearful of the man and described him as wreckless. Local police in Barrie have labeled this killing a femicide.

Cause of Death: Unknown

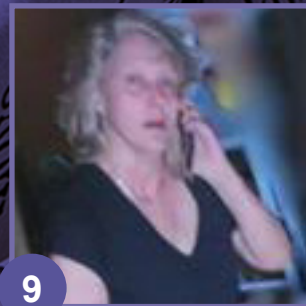


RENÉE DESCARY, 51

Renée was a hard worker and had worked for the Canadian Revenue Agency and was dedicated to making her community better for everyone, volunteering her time to support her local housing co-op. She is described by family, neighbours and friends as a loving, kind and compassionate human being who will be missed by all who knew her. A 24 year old man, with no prior relationship to Renée, has been charged with 2nd degree murder in relation to her death. Local police in Ottawa have labeled this killing a femicide.

Rachelle, also known as Francis, will be always remembered and missed by her loved ones, family, friends and community. Rachelle had been reported missing prior to her death and her body has not been located at the time of this report's publication. No relationship details were provided within media reports, however, the killing has been reported to be targeted. Local police in Ottawa have labeled this killing a femicide.

The victim will be dearly missed by her family, friends and community. The victim's identity has not been disclosed publicly. A 34 year old man, reported to be the victim's son-in-law, has been charged with 2nd degree murder in relation to the victim's death.

JULY 2, 2025 - SUDBURY, ON

The victim has been described as a beloved mother, wife, family member and as a person who was full of love and cared for everyone. She will be missed and mourned by her family, friends and community. The victim was from Nigeria and was here in Canada visiting her daughter at the time she was killed. The victim's 36 year old son-in-law has been charged with 1st degree murder, attempted murder, possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose, forcible confinement and strangulation, relating to the victim's death and against his intimate partner who survived the attack.

A 64 year old man has been charged with 2nd degree murder and two counts of aggravated assault, relating to the victim's death and two other victims who survived the attack. According to media reports, just 5 days prior he had been charged with wilfully causing unnecessary pain and suffering to an animal.

He was also reportedly charged with indecent exhibition and assault on a police officer the day prior to Tracey's death and attempted murder, assault with a weapon and aggravated assault for another incident that occurred following her death. Local police in Ottawa have labeled this killing a femicide.

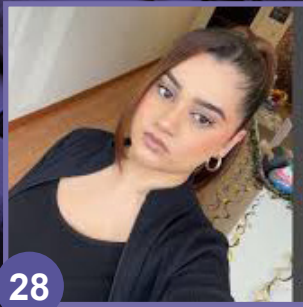

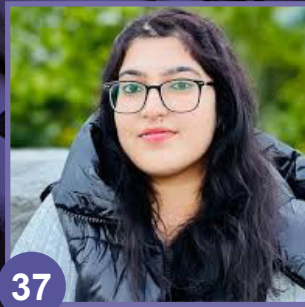

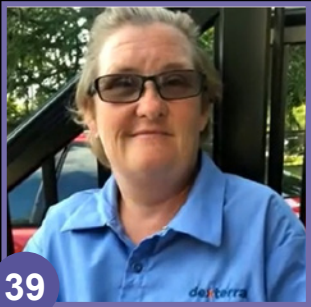
